

Guidance:

Key advice:

- Re-read/watch all your set texts. As you read, make a list of key themes and ideas. Make a list of the key characters in each text - what is their ‘arc’? How do they develop? What is the artistic intention? What vocal/physical skills are the actors using?
- Learn your lines for Devising and Presenting and Performing Texts as soon as you have your scripts.
- Practise Blood Brothers exam questions in timed conditions. Remember, 8 mark questions will need more time. Start with them first.
- Practise planning essay question (Section B) in timed conditions. Even just writing an introduction and one paragraph is a great way to develop your skills and then you can further expand on this
